

START A FAMILY CHILD CARE BUSINESS ! SPANISH LICENSING PROGRAM

The GOALS OF THE PROGRAM ARE:

- To help Latino families open licensed family child care businesses.
- To increase the number of licensed Spanish speaking family child care providers in Boulder County.
- To improve the quality of the child care services available to Spanish speaking families and prepare children to be successful in school.
- To provide a support network for Spanish speaking child care providers.
- To improve access to resources for Spanish speaking providers.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Spanish speaking people living in Boulder County who enjoy children.
- Your home must have a fenced yard or a yard that can be fenced.
- All adults (age 18 or older) who live in the home must pass a criminal background check (no convictions for domestic violence, child abuse or neglect, violent or drug related crimes).
- All adults (age 18 or older) who live in the home must be a U.S. Citizen or be a legal resident of the United States.

THE PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Orientation to Family Child Care and Pre-licensing classes conducted in English with Spanish interpretation. Written materials are provided in Spanish.
- Health and safety classes conducted in Spanish.
- A Spanish speaking coach who will assist each participant through the application and licensing process.
- A monthly support group meeting with other Latino providers.
- Ongoing Spanish training and interpretation at English training events.
